26.	29.09.2017	<p><u>SPECIAL ACHIEVEMENT BY CHANDIGARH POLICE WHILE NABBING ACCUSED IN MURDER CASE</u></p> <p>Chandigarh police achieved a major success by nabbing the person namely Sunil S/o Ganda lal R/o # 481/A, EWS, Dhanas, Chandigarh who was involved in the murder of a girl namely Pooja R/o Sec-56, Chandigarh within a short span.</p> <p>On 29.9.17 at about 12.45 PM a wireless message was received in police station that someone has stabbed the neck of girl near shop no.26 grain market Sec-26, Chd. Upon this information the police party reached at the spot and found the victim girl was shifted to PGI by PCR vehicle. A girl resident of BDC, Sec-26, Chd met to the police at the spot who stated that she along with her friend namely Pooja were present at grain market and selling vegetables at about 12.30 PM, one boy namely Sunil came there and trying to talk with Pooja. She further stated that Sunil was annoyed with Pooja from last some days. Today Sunil asked to Pooja to go with him but pooja denied the same, in this act the said boy Sunil put out a knife from his pocket and stabbed the neck of Pooja and fled away from the spot. Thereafter, the PCR vehicle rushed the victim at PGI Sec-12, Chd.</p> <p>The case FIR No. 204 dated 29.9.17 U/S 307 IPC was registered on the above statement of Jyoti D/o Sh. Ram Avtar Singh R/o # 52, Phase-2 BDC, Sec-26, Chd in a meantime the information was received in police station from PGI Sec-12, Chd that the admitted girl Pooja succumbed to injuries. Section 302 IPC has been added.</p> <p>During the course of investigation, a team under the supervision of Insp Jaspal Singh SHO-26, Chd played a pivotal role in arresting the accused Sunil S/o Ganda lal R/o # 481/A, EWS, Dhanas, Chandigarh from area near timber market Sec-26, Chandigarh. Weapon of offence i.e. Knife is recovered, blood stained clothes of the accused and his foot wear has been recovered. The investigation of the case is in progress.</p>

Two Mobile phones were recovered from them at the time of arrest which they disclosed that they snatched these mobiles</p>

(arrested from Delhi). <p>Credible information about identity of accused persons who were suspected to be members of an interstate gang was shared with crime branch team headed by ACP Jasbir. A joint team of Police Station Sec 26 and Crime branch Delhi nabbed the accused based on the information provided by PS 26 team. At about 2.30 AM joint teams raided a suspicious house at J.J. Colony, WazidPur, Delhi and nabbed the above said three persons red handed, who were in possession of stolen articles of S.D. Mandir Sector-27 UT, Chandigarh. All the stolen articles i.e. five Mukut of Silver, one snake Silver, one base of Shivling Silver, one Jhallar of Shivling recovered from their possession.</p> <p>On questioning, the above said accused admitted there involvement other burglary incident of temples in and around Chandigarh. Persons belonging to categories such as school dropouts, juvenile offenders, victim of crime, unskilled laborer, drug addicted/de-addicted and very poor, who can't afford coaching fee have been encouraged. After completion of courses, they would be provided with certificates. Today, 90 persons from Bapu Dham Colony, Colony No. 4, Village-Daria, Sector-18 & 20 were interviewed by SSP/CHD Nilambari Jagadale, DSP/EAST Satish Kumar and SHOs of Police Station-26, 19 & Ind. Area. Out of these, 29 persons have been selected for the above courses. This community policing initiative will go a long way in discouraging vulnerable youths from entering the world of drugs & crime.</p>
