The special tool kit bag containing said special instruments has recovered from their possession.

"Choron Ko Par Gaye Mor", After committed the theft, they equally divided the stolen property between them. Accused Shyam Mandal kept his cash into his room at Balongi, where a marriage function was being celebrated, where he consumed liquor and under the influence of liquor he was flying money over the dancing ladies. Somehow, the neighbors noticed that he has huge money and Rs. 11 Lacs of his share was further stolen by someone from his room.
