38.	25.10.2020	<p>Chandigarh Police has succeeded in arresting another accused Gurmeet Singh @ Geeta Age 25 years S/o Jarnail Singh R/o Village Rurki Fukta, PS Gharuan, Distt. Mohali (Pb) in a sensational murder case of Gural Singh Brar. He is also a member of Davinder Bambiha gang. He along with his co-accused Gurwinder Singh had provided Motor Cycle to the shooters on which they run away after shooting.</p> <p>That on the night intervening 10/11-10-2020 at about 12/12-15AM two persons fired gun shot on a person who was parking his Fortuner Car bearing Regn No. PB 29-U-9988 on the footpath in front of main gate of the City Emporium After firing 6-7 gun shots they ran away on a Motor Cycle which was already parked by another person in a start position. The person shot dead was identified as Gurlal Singh Brar S/o Sat Pal Singh R/o Village Burj Harika, Distt. Faridkot.</p> <p>After this incident, police swung into action and constituted 5 teams of Sub Division East under the supervision of SSP/Chandigarh, Shri Vineet Kumar, SP/City and headed by Shri Gurmukh Singh SDPO, East. During investigation, accused Gurwinder Singh S/o Avtar Singh R/o Village Rurki Pukta, Distt. SAS Nagar Mohali was arrested on 21.10.20 and obtained his police custody upto 25.10.2020. During his sustained interrogation, police succeeded to arrest the above said accused Gurmeet Singh @ Geeta who disclosed that while he was in Nabha Jail in 307 IPC case, accused Gaurav @ Lucky, and other active members of Davinder Bambiha gang were also in Nabha jail. He was working for them as (MASHAKTI), cooks food, utensils cleaning and, washing their clothes in jail premises so he was regular in touch with Gaurav Lucky on whatsapp audio/video calls. After the encounter of Davinder Bambiha, Sukhpreet Budha and Dilpreet Bawa are acting as head of this gang. He was asked by Gaurav Lucky to provide Motor Cycle with fake registration to his persons. So he alongwith Gurwinder Singh arranged Motor Cycle with fake No Plates to Neeraj Chaska, Maan and others at Sunny Enclave Kharar to commit a crime. He is a conspirator in this crime and also a member of Davinder Bambiha gang. The said Gurmeet Singh is a drug addict and also used to sale drug. He was assured by Gaurav Lucky that 20 grams heroine will be given to him in lieu of providing the bike. Gaurav Lucky is going to provide money to Geeta so that he could go to Hazoor Sahib in Maharashtra.</p> <p>Based on a secret information and further interrogation of co-accused Gurwinder Singh, the above said accused has been arrested from near Bus Stand Sector 43 on 25.10.2020 while he was trying to go to Maharashtra to save him from the arrest. . Further investigation is on progress. He will be produced in the court by tomorrow and will</p>

39.	12.11.2020	<p><u>Recovery of weapon from criminals</u></p> <p>On 06.11.2020, Dilpreet Singh @ Baba was brought on production warrant in Gurlal Murder case from Distt. Jail Sangrur (PB) and was produced in the court of Illaqa Magistrate from where his 3 days police custody was obtained. During interrogation Chandigarh Police has succeeded in the recovery of 4 illegal weapons (Pistol .32 Bore-3 and Deshi Katta-1) from Dilpreet Singh @ Baba and Gudreep Singh @ Deepa. He also disclosed the names of the shooters namely Neeraj Gupta @ Chaska and Ajay @ Maan both residents of Jaiton Distt. Faridkot (PB) who were involved in the Gurlal murder case.</p> <p>During further interrogation, he disclosed that he had given a .32 Bore Pistol to one Gurdeep Singh @ Deepa S/O Darshan Singh, R/O Raipur adjoining village of Dilpreet Singh @ Bawa, PS- Nurpur Bedi, Distt-Rup Nagar (Punjab). On the basis of his disclosure statement as well as secret information, Gurdeep Singh @ Deepa was apprehended on 09.11.2020 from Industrial Area, Phase-1. Chandigarh and recovered .32 Bore Pistol from his possession. A separate FIR No. 205 dated 09.11.2020 U/S 25/54/59 Arms Act was registered against accused Gurdeep Singh @ Deepa.</p> <p>On 09.11.2020 the accused Dilpreet Singh @ Baba again produced in the court and obtained 3 days further police remand. During his sustained interrogation in second time remand</p>

period by a team headed by Sh. Gurmukh Singh, SDPO/East Sub Division, under the close supervision of SSP, Chandigarh he broke and further disclosed that while he was absconded from police custody, he brought a large consignment of Arms and Ammunition from Madhya Pradesh to take the revenge from his anti group (Lawrence Bishnoi gang) as they are disturbing their persons for collecting the extortion money from Panchkula, Baddi, Mohali and Chandigarh and they also killed some of their associates. So, they wanted to take revenge from the anti group by killing them. He distributed the arms and ammunition to his gang members as per the planning, out of which some have been arrested and weapons given to them have also been recovered by the police of different states.

Dilpreet @ Baba further confessed before the investigating team that 3 weapons had kept near Ganda Nalah towards Railway Station Road, Chandigarh and on the basis of his disclosure statement, police party succeeded in making further recovery of three weapons (.32 Bore Pistol-2 + Deshi Katta-1) on his instance. These weapons were kept by him for further distribution to his gang member as and when required by them to kill the active members of anti group. A separate FIR regarding the recovery of weapon under Arms Act against Dilpreet Singh @ Baba has been registered at PS-IA. The accused Dilpreet Singh @ Baba has also been confronted with Sukhpreet Singh @ Budha who was brought on production warrant from Sangrur Jail in Surjit murder case of Sector-38, Chandigarh. During confrontation, Sukhpreet Singh @ Budha also corroborated the version of Dilpreet Singh @ Baba that Gurlal Singh Brar was shot dead by Neeraj @ Chaska and Mani @ Maan, both resident of Jaiton (Punjab) on the direction of Gaurav Patial @ Lucky and Vinay Deora as they are also members of their gang. The main motive to kill Gurlal Singh Brar was that they were in mind that Lovy Deora who was younger brother of Vinay Deora was shot dead by the member of Lawrence group and Gurlal Singh was one of the associate for killing Lovy Deora but he was not arrested by the Punjab police. So, they took revenge by killing Gurlal Singh Brar. The hideouts of shooters Neeraj @ Chaska and Mani @ Maan are being raided by the police teams. They are also wanted to Punjab Police in many murder cases registered in difference districts of Punjab.
