Chandigarh Administration has been receiving various representation/requests from allottees of Government accommodations, who were/are due to vacate their houses but unable to do so due to outbreak of second wave of COVID-19 and the concomitant curfews/ lockdown orders.

This extraordinary situation has been considered by the Chandigarh Administration and it has been decided to allow suo-moto retention of Govt. houses from 01.04.2021 to 30.06.2021 uniformly applicable for all, as one time measure, under Govt. Residences (Chandigarh Administration General Pool) Allotment Rules, 1996 as amended from time to time.

The suo-moto retention period will be on the payment of normal licence fee as applicable to the allottee under Rule 13. No penal rent will be charged for this period. The usual occupation and vacation period will be extended accordingly.

These relaxations will also be given to such allottees who have become unauthorized occupants of Govt. accommodation on or before 01.04.2021. However, in such cases, after the expiry of retention period i.e. upto 30.06.2021, the penal rent at the rate as was applicable prior to this period will be resumed.




