ORDER

In pursuance of order passed in CWP No. 10042 (O&M) dated 08.11.2017 by Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh that in compliance of the directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in judgement of Union of India Vs. Mohanlal and another, (2016) 3SCC379 the contraband drugs disposal report shall be submit half yearly in the shape of status report before the Hon'ble Court. The Registrar General, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh has conveyed that directions may be issued to all SHOs/Investigation Officers to ensure to move the applications (permission to dispose of the contrabands) regarding the narcotic drugs lying in Malkhanas immediately on the completion of proceedings under section 52A(2) of NDPS Act. Suggestive Notes at Annexure-'C' received from Registrar General, Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh is enclosed.

Hence, All SHOs of Police Stations of Chandigarh Police, are hereby, directed to pursue the matter on their own level and get the required permission from concerned District Court Magistrate to dispose of seized contraband drugs lying in Malkhanas of Police Stations without any reason. All SHOs/Investigating Officers are also directed to provide the detail of all NDPS Act cases in prescribed proforma (copy enclosed) to DSP/Crime in which required permission already obtained from concerned court for further dispose of contraband drugs as per procedures.

For Chandigarh

Storage Facility

- \* Storage facilities means the separate room in which Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances only be retained and not any other item should be there.
- \* A separate room in the form of storage facilities along with double locking and vault has to be established. It seems that U.T., Chandigarh did not take any step to establish such kind of storage so it is further requested to write a letter to the Centre Government or to the U.T. Administrator to establish the storage facilities.
- \* To provide the address as well as dimensions of the separate or storage room of each district.
- \* To provide the name and designation along with mobile numbers of the Gazetted Officers, who have been appointed to supervise and control of storage facility of each district.
- \* Gazetted Officers be directed to give the details of their visits to the storage facilities per month.
- \* Key of the storage room must be in control of the Gazetted Officer/ In-charge of Storage.
- \* CCTV Cameras (with Wi-Fi connection) be installed with 24 hours backup of electricity for the storage facility.
- \* No access in the storage room shall be allowed, except the concerned Gazetted Officer/ In-charge or with the prior permission of the Gazetted Officer/ In-charge.

Disposal

- \* The Drug Disposal Committee held its meetings two times only within the period of six months. It is advised and suggested that the Drug Disposal Committee meeting should be held at least once in 15 days or twice in one month as per the requirement to expedite the process of disposal of Narcotics.
