

Subject: Standing Order for charging of Compounding Fee for MV Act Challans.

The Police Officers (not below the rank of Sub Inspector) of Chandigarh Traffic Police shall charge the maximum fee as specified in Chandigarh Administration Notification No.2/5/52/90-HIII (2)/26741 dated 29th December, 1994 for compounding of M.V. Act challans. In cases where it is established that the offence was not willfully committed by the offender, a lenient view may be taken & a reduction of the compounding fee (upto half the maximum amount applicable) may be authorized in writing by the SP/Traffic or DSP/Traffic, Chandigarh. The reduction in the fee for any single challan cannot exceed 50% of the maximum amount applicable or Rs.500/- whichever is lesser. In case, the grounds exist for recommending the cancellation of a challan, the challan should be sent to the court of the concerned judicial magistrate alongwith a report by DSP/Traffic clearly citing the grounds for recommending the cancellation.






