PUBLIC NOTICE FOR CBT FOR RECRUITMENT OF CONSTABLES

Chandigarh Police is going to conduct Computer Based Test (CBT) for the post of 520 constables (shortlisted in Physical Efficiency & Measurement Test (PE&MT)) on 15th, 16th & 17th November, 2018:-

1. Link to download **E-Call Letter** for appearing in the Computer Based test shall be available at Chandigarh Police website i.e. <http://chandigarhpolice.gov.in> from 8th November 2018 onward.
2. Intimation regarding E-Call Letter is being also sent by Email and SMS on the registered email ID and phone number (submitted at the time of registration) of the candidates respectively from 8th November 2018 onward.
3. A Help Desk has been setup at Chandigarh Police Headquarters, Sector-09, U.T Chandigarh, PIN-160009 to assist the candidates to download their E-Call Letter and to address all related queries, which shall be available from 09:00 AM to 06:00 PM on all days (including holidays) from 8th to 16th November, 2018.
4. Candidates can also call at toll free helpline No.**1800-419-2929**, which shall be available from 08:00 AM to 08:00 PM on all days (including holidays) from 8th to 16th November, 2018.
5. Candidates can also call Mobile helpline No.**08284888777**, which shall be available from 09:00 AM to 06:00 PM on all days (including holidays) from 8th to 16th November, 2018.
6. Information regarding exact examination centre address will be provided to all the candidates 48 hours prior to examination i.e. on 13th November, 2018 through Email & SMS. In addition, details regarding examination centre address will also be uploaded on the website of Chandigarh Police i.e. <http://chandigarhpolice.gov.in> 48 hours prior to the test.
7. Candidates are advised to locate their examination centre and its accessibility at least one day before the test so that they can reach the examination centre on time on the day of the test.
8. No request for change in examination centre will be considered under any circumstances.

9. No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination centre after gate closing time.
10. Candidates should report at the examination centre well in advance of the reporting time indicated on the E-Call Letter to complete activities such as verification, frisking, matching of biometrics and photo, checking of documents, announcement of instructions and logging in etc.
11. Candidates without photograph on the E-Call Letter will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
12. Candidates must bring an '**ORIGINAL PHOTO ID**' such as Voter Card, Aadhaar Card, Driving License, PAN card, Passport, Identity Card issued by employer in case the candidate is a Govt. Employee to appear in the examination. **Photocopy of ID proof will not be accepted.**
13. The duration of CBT will be 105 minutes for 100 questions. Questions and options will be available in English, Hindi and Punjabi languages only. There will be 01 mark of each correct option and for every wrong option, 0.25 marks will be deducted.
14. There will be no safekeeping or locker arrangement for candidate's belongings. Chandigarh Police will not be responsible for its safe custody.
15. Possession and/or use of electronic devices such as Mobile Phone, Micro Phone, Watch, Headphone, Ear piece, Bluetooth device or any other associated accessories such as Calculator, Log tables, Pen, Blank Paper, Pager, Digital Diary Books, food items etc are strictly prohibited in the Examination centre. If any candidate is found to be in possession of and/or using any of these devices/documents, his/her candidature shall be liable to be cancelled and criminal action shall be taken against him/her as per law.
16. Indulging in any type of malpractice/unfair means/ impersonation misbehaviour/indiscipline in the Examination Hall will disqualify the candidate and he/she may be debarred from all future Chandigarh Police examinations & appointment in Chandigarh Police and shall be liable for criminal action as per law.
17. Any candidate whose identity is found to be incorrect based on personal details and/or biometrics at the time of checking at the test centre, will not be allowed to appear in the test. However, in case there is any difficulty in establishing the identity of a candidate using Aadhaar based authentication, he/she will be allowed to appear in

the test provisionally subject to his/her verification by a Screening Committee of Chandigarh Police.

18. For the benefit of candidates, a mock test on the pattern of CBT is available for familiarization & practice on the website of Chandigarh police i.e. <http://chandigarhpolice.gov.in> from 8th November 2018 onward.
