

ORDER

It has been observed that generally while passing any orders relating to the award of punishments to the Chandigarh Police personnel under the Punjab Police Rules, as applicable to U.T. Police, the name and designation of the Appellate Authority and the period of limitation under the PPR by which the appeal can be preferred against such orders, are not mentioned in orders by the Disciplinary Authorities. It results into non-availing of the opportunity of preferring appeal by the affected police personnel. As such, all the disciplinary authorities of Chandigarh Police are, hereby, directed that whenever any order awarding the punishment under the provisions of Chapter XVI of the Punjab Police Rules is passed, the name and designation of the Appellate Authority and the period within which appeal can be preferred must be indicated on the top of or at the end of such order.
