

ORDER

It is hereby ordered that the night checking GO and all night checking officers of the Inspector rank will assemble at the Police Control Room at 11.45 pm for necessary briefing and the preparation before they start night checking. The night checking GO will first obtain the details of important calls during the day and brief the night checking Inspectors about any special measures to be taken during the night patrolling regarding these incidents. The night checking officer will also distribute at least 2 police personnel to each night inspectors from his reserve, out of which at least 1 should be armed. The night checking GO will also check that wireless system, hooters / siren and other accessories required for patrolling like torches, cane etc. are available in each night inspector's gypsy. The night checking GO will also fix a convenient place for debriefing with all the inspectors at the time of closing of patrolling.

It has also been observed that Police nakas during the day or the night are not well equipped for doing effective checking of suspects. These are found to be wanting in following respects.

1. The number of police personnel deployed is not adequate. It should be ensured by the SDPO / SHO concerned that at least 4 Police personnel should be deployed at each naka. As far as possible PCR and traffic should also be involved while deploying these nakas.
2. It should also be ensured that police personnel deployed at these nakas are equipped with cane, arms (as per entitlement), reflective jackets and torches during the night. They should also have list of stolen vehicles during last 24 hours.
3. It has also been observed that at daily nakas proper formation of barricades is not done, which results in vehicles speeding by the naka without stopping for checking. It is the responsibility of the concerned SHO to brief the Police personnel deployed at the naka so that barricades are placed in a manner which slows down the vehicles passing through the naka.
4. It is also felt that proper drill of checking and frisking is not being done which may result assaults on Police personnel. To avoid such situations Police personnel deployed on the nakas or doing foot / mobile patrolling should be properly briefed so that they can effectively sanitize and neutralize the suspect.
