The National Road Safety Week is observed in January every year all over the country to inculcate the culture of road safety amongst the citizens. Chandigarh Traffic Police is organizing the 26th Road Safety Week 2015 in UT, Chandigarh from 27th January to 2nd February, 2015 with the theme “Safety is not just a slogan, It’s a way of life.”



Today, on the second day of this 26th National Road Safety Week, a Road Safety Workshop for School Bus Drivers/CTU Bus Drivers/conductors was held at Auditorium Traffic & Security Lines, Sector-29B, Chandigarh to aware them about traffic rules and regulations. About 300 Bus drivers/conductors took part in this workshop. Sh.Sanjay Sehrawat DANIPS, DSP/Traffic/Central Zone delivered the lecture on Road Safety to the drivers. Experts from **Society of Indian Auto Mobile Manufactures (SIAM) New Delhi** delivered the lecture on Road Safety to the drivers. A team from Eye Hospital, Sohana also organized a free Eye Testing Camp and medical checkup for the bus drivers/conductors. In this Medical Check-up Camp, basic health tests were conducted by the team of expert doctors and accordingly required consultations and prescriptions were given to bus drivers/conductors/police personnel who were checked by this team of doctors. Literatures on road safety were also distributed by Traffic Police. The participants have been given tips on road safety and films on road safety were also shown to them.

Beside this Road Safety Workshops were also organized in Vivek High School Sector 38, Chandigarh, Home Science College Sector 10, Chandigarh, Govt. College for Boys Sector 11, Chandigarh, St. Stephon School Sector 45, Chandigarh, DAV College Sector 10, Chandigarh, Govt. College for Girls Sector 11, Chandigarh and Institute of Hotel Management Sector 42, Chandigarh. In these workshops students of the educational institutions participated, traffic Inspectors and traffic

marshals delivered the lecture on road safety and distributed the road safety literatures to the participants. Films on road safety were also shown to aware them about the traffic rules and regulations.

A seven days road safety exhibition from 27th Jan to 2nd Feb 2015 is installed at Plaza Sector 17, Chandigarh to aware the general public regarding the road safety and traffic rules/regulation by showing films & road safety videos. The literature on road safety is also being distributed among the Public to aware them regarding road safety. Public announcement are also being made at the major light Points.
