- 4. Khyali Ram Meena s/o Ramchandra Meena r/o H-654, Palam Vihar, Gurgaon age 46 yrs

The Cyber Crime Investigation Cell received a complaint from PGIMER official and subsequently, a case u/s 420, 120B, 511 IPC was registered. During investigation, it was revealed that Mohit and Harpreet called the candidates who appeared for the interview in the above said recruitment process and promised them selection on a paid seat after payment of a negotiable amount. They were supplied with the details like name, application no. phone no. etc of the candidates by Khyali Ram Meena and Ashok Kumar who obtained these details from the website of PGIMER by downloading the concerned notification from archives and then using Application no. as Login ID and date of birth as password on Candidates' login portal, they obtained details of all the candidates. They then used these details to call up the selected candidates and allure them with sure-shot selection on a paid seat after payment of a negotiable amount.
