Today, on 22/05/2015 the Closing Ceremony of Drug Awareness Week was organized in Govt. Senior Secondary School, Dhanas, Chandigarh. Sh. Vijay Kumar Dev, IAS, Advisor to the Administrator, Chandigarh was the Chief Guest on the occasion. Sh. R.P. Upadhyay, IPS, IGP/UT, Dr. Sukhchain Singh Gill, IPS, SSP/UT, Sh.
