

Gang rape: Co-accused sent to three-day police remand

A local court sent Kamal Hassan, alias Dil, co-accused in the 2016 gang rape case, to three-day police remand.

The police had, however, sought a five-day remand of Hassan who, along with Mohammad Irfan, an auto driver, was arrested for raping a 21-year-old call centre employee in Sector 29 here

in December 2016.

Hassan was arrested in Delhi on the basis of a disclosure by Irfan, who is also his relative.

He was earlier sent to judicial custody last week since his test identification parade (TIP) was to be conducted.

The cops pleaded that the mobile and the weapon used in the crime was yet to be recovered. It was also mentioned that his blood sample was to be taken for

DNA analysis and that he may be involved in several other such cases.

Irfan, who is in judicial custody for raping a Dehradun girl along with his accomplices in Sector 53 last November, was also involved in the 2016 gang rape, the UT police had told the court on Tuesday.

A forensic test had found Irfan's DNA sample to be a "contributor" in the call centre employee's rape.

Juvenile among two arrested for molesting 13-year-old

CHANDIGARH: Two people, including a juvenile, have been arrested for sexually assaulting a 13-year-old girl in Ram Darbar.

The victim alleged that Ravi, also a resident of Ram Darbar, entered her house forcibly and took her away on his Activa on

March 10. She said Ravi's juvenile brother and one Ajay, alias Golu, followed them.

The girl was allegedly taken to Japanese Garden, Sector 31, where the trio assaulted her.

**MAIN ACCUSED
ABSCONDING**

A case was registered under Sections 323 (voluntarily causing hurt), 363 (kidnapping), 354

(assault or use of criminal force to woman with intent to outrage her modesty), 354A (sexual harassment) and 120B (criminal conspiracy) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and Section 8 (sexual assault) of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act at the Sector-31 police station. While Ajay and the juvenile were arrested, Ravi is on the run.
