डड्डूमाजरा में छठी की छात्रा से पड़ोसी युवक ने घर में घुसकर दुराचार किया। बुधवार दोपहर दो बजे वारदात के समय 12 वर्षीय बच्ची की मां काम करने गई थी। यहां से लौटी को घर में बेटी बेसुख पड़ी थी। मां ने बच्ची की हालत देख पूछा तो उसने आपबीती बताई। परिवार ने पुलिस को सूचना दी और बच्ची को सेक्टर-16 अस्पताल में भर्ती कराया।

पुलिस ने देर रात आरोपी को डड्डूमाजरा के चार मंजिला क्वार्टर के पास से गिरफ्तार कर लिया है। उसकी पहचान डड्डूमाजरा के ही रहने वाले शम्भू कुमार के रूप में हुई है। आरोपी पीड़िता बच्ची के घर के ऊपर पहली मंजिल पर पिछले छह साल से रह रहा है। आरोपी चंडीगढ़ सेक्टर-सात के एक स्टोर में नौकरी के बाद घर लौटा था। बच्ची ने महिला पुलिस को बताया कि एक व्यक्ति किराए के कमरे को खोजबीन करता घर के अंदर दाखिल हुआ। उसने कहा कमरा नहीं है तो आरोपी ने पानी मांगा। वह पानी लेने जा रही थी कि पीछे से आरोपी ने उसका मुंह दबा लिया और दुराचार कर फरार हो गया। डॉक्टरों ने बच्ची की हालत खतरों से बाहर बहाई है।

सीटीयू बस में महिला से छेड़छाड़, आरोपी गिरफ्तार

हल्सोमाजरा लाइट प्वाइंट पर सीटीयू बस में सवार एक महिला से एक व्यक्ति ने छेड़छाड़ की। महिला ने पहले आरोपी को नजरअंदाज किया, लेकिन जब वह बाज नहीं आया तो महिला ने पीसीआर को सूचना दे दी। इससे भड़के आरोपी ने बस में महिला का हाथ पकड़ लिया। महिला के शोर मचाने पर चालक ने बस रोक दी और चालक-कंडक्टर सहित बस सवार अन्य दो महिलाएं महिला के पास पहुंच गईं। इसके बाद सभी ने आरोपी को पकड़ कर पुलिस को बुला लिया। सेक्टर-31 थाना पुलिस ने

आरोपी को गिरफ्तार कर केस दर्ज कर लिया है। आरोपी की पहचान जौरकपुर के लोहगढ़ पार्क के समीप शर्मा एस्टेट निवासी बनिंदर सिंह के रूप में हुई। शिकायतकर्ता महिला ने पुलिस को बताया कि मंगलवार रात करीब सवा आठ बजे वह घर जाने के लिए हल्सोमाजरा लाइट प्वाइंट से सीटीयू की बस में चढ़ी थी। आरोपी भी उसी बस में सवार था। इसके बाद आरोपी महिला के इर्द-गिर्द घूमने लगा और छेड़छाड़ शुरू कर दी। महिला ने आपत्ति जताई, लेकिन आरोपी बाज नहीं आया। महिला जब पुलिस को फोन करने लगी तो आरोपी ने उनका हाथ पकड़ लिया। बहुरहाल, थाना पुलिस ने आरोपी से पूछताछ कर उसे गिरफ्तार कर आगामी कार्रवाई शुरू कर दी है।

सीसीटीवी की फुटेज खंगाली

पुलिस ने पीड़िता के घर के आसपास लगे सीसीटीवी में वारदात के समय से पहले और बाद की फुटेज भी खंगाली। एक कैमरे की फुटेज में पुलिस को 4-5 संदिग्ध लोग नजर आए थे। थाना पुलिस ने देर रात आरोपी को घर दबोचा।

एसएसपी भी तलाश में निकलीं

शहर की महिलाओं-युवतियों व बच्चों को सकंते में डाल देने वाली इस घिनौनी वारदात के बाद एसएसपी निलंबनी विजय जगदले ने भी पुलिस थाना पहुंचकर चप्पा-चप्पा खंगालने के निर्देश दिए। थाना मलौया के एसएचओ सहित साउथ डिवीजन के अन्य सभी एसएचओ अलग-अलग जगहों पर आरोपी की तलाश में तुरंत जुट गए थे।

Youth held for raping 12-yr-old girl

Accused stays in the same building while the victim lives on the ground floor

A 20-YEAR-OLD youth, Shami Kumar, was arrested for allegedly raping a 12-year-old girl at her house in Dadumajra Colony, Sector 38, Chandigarh, on Wednesday. The accused Shami, residing in a double-storey house on rent along with his family, and the victim's house was located on the ground floor of the same building. Shami works at a departmental store in Sector 7.

The incident took place around 12 pm when the victim was alone at home. Her parents, both labourers, were on their jobs.

Police said Shami was arrested when the victim identified him when she was returning after recording her statement under Section 164 CrPC before a magistrate and spotted the accused near Dadumajra quarters in Sector 38 late in the evening.

Police said a police party was also with the victim when she identified the accused Shami. He fled after committing the crime. Police said the victim informed her mother

over phone about the incident and later it was brought to the knowledge of local police.

The victim's mother told police that initially the man asked her daughter about some house address and later demanded a glass of water. As her daughter went to the kitchen, the man bolted the door from inside and committed the crime, she further informed the police.

Police sources said the girl, bleeding from her private parts, was rushed to GMSH-16. She was discharged after two hours. All the SHOs of south division were called to the spot and tasks of verifying CCTV cameras installed in the locality, suspects staying in the colony and interaction with the victim were assigned to them.

The victim's mother informed the police that her daughter was a Class VI student at a local government school and on Wednesday she was home because of a holiday.

SSP (UT) Nilambri Vijay Jagdale said, "Accused Shami Kumar has been residing in the same building in which the family of vic-

tim resides, for the last six years. He was arrested on being identified by the victim. He was also captured on a CCTV camera installed in the locality."

A neighbour said, "We did not hear the victim scream and also did not see any suspicious man. The victim informed her mother over phone about the incident and later we saw several police personnel in the area." Another neighbour said, "It was around 12.45 pm when we heard the shouting of the victim's mother and subsequently, four police personnel, including women police, appeared. Later, the victim, along with her family members, went to hospital on a police vehicle."

Around 20 police personnel were stationed in the locality and media persons were not allowed to meet the victim's family. A woman police constable said SI Mini Bhardwaj was in charge of the investigation.

A case under section 376 (rape) of the IPC and Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act was registered at Maloya police station.



CRACKDOWN ON DRINK DRIVING

7 driving licenses found to be fake, recommended for cancellation

WHEN 23-YEAR-OLD Umesh Kumar, a resident of Mauli Jagran, was caught by traffic police in November 2017 for speeding on his motorcycle near IT Park, he handed over his licence to the police. On December 26, Umesh was arrested for submitting a fake licence. An FIR against Umesh had been registered at the Industrial Area police station a day earlier. Umesh was one of the seven people whose driving licenses turned out to be fake of the hundreds challaned since last February for traffic offences such as speeding or drunk driving.

"Seven cases were reported by the licensing authorities concerned about the fake licences. We had approached these authori-

ties to recommend the cancellation of driving licences," said a senior traffic police officer.

From February 2017, UT Traffic Police have been recommending cancellation of licence for six offences, including speeding, drunk driving, overloading, using mobile phones, jumping signals, ferrying persons in goods and carriage vehicles.

Umesh claimed in his interrogation that even he was not aware that his licence was fake. In yet another case, the driving licence of a Kanpur resident, Ranjeev Yadav, challaned for drunk driving, was found to be fake when RLA, Kanpur, submitted a report in the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate (CJM), Akash Deep Mahajan, that the licence was not issued by the authorities.

An FIR against Yadav was lodged at PS 36 on January 29 and efforts were on to nab him.

Police sources said findings of four fake driving licences out of seven were submitted by RLA, Chandigarh, one by RLA, Sonapat, in Haryana, and finding of two other licences were submitted by RLA, Kanpur and Bulandshahr.

DIG OP Mishra said, "We recommend the cancellation of driving licenses to the concerned RLA authorities. In four of the cases, licenses were recommended by traffic police for verification and later they were found fake. Other three cases were registered on the complaints of staff members of district courts when people submitted the licenses to get their impounded vehicles released."

On May 26, 2017, Balwinder Singh and Ram Milan of Sector 52, were arrested for submitting fake licenses of RLA, Bulandshahr, in court to get their three-wheelers, seized in a case of drink driving, released.
