CHANDIGARH: The Crime Branch of Chandigarh Police arrested a lady resident of Daddu Majra, Chandigarh near Government School Sector-38W, Chandigarh and recovered 600 grammes of ganja from her possession. 19-YR-OLD HELD FOR TRYING TO RAPE 3-YR-OLD

CHANDIGARH: Police have arrested a 19-year-old labourer for allegedly trying to rape a three-year-old girl in Maloya on Sunday.

Police officials said the girl went to accused Dharamvir's house to watch television, when he tore her clothes and sexually assaulted her. "The girl narrated the incident to her mother on returning home, following which a complaint was lodged," said Baldev Kumar, station house officer (SHO), Maloya.

He added that medical examination of the minor confirmed she was not raped.

A case under Section 376 (rape) read with 511 (attempting to commit offences punishable to with imprisonment for life) of Indian Penal Code (IPC) and Section 8 (sexual assault) of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act has been registered against the accused. He will be produced in court on Monday. **HTC**

4-year-old minor girl raped at Maloya

CHANDIGARH: A four-year-old girl was allegedly raped by a 19-year-old boy in Maloya, Chandigarh, following which the accused was apprehended by the Chandigarh Police. The accused has been identified as 19-year-old Dharam Veer, a resident of Maloya who works as a labourer. The parents of the minor were not present at home during the incident. The accused entered the house while the girl was alone and the accused allegedly raped her.

The family of the minor girl has been living in Maloya at a rented house for a long. As per the reports, around 12:30 p.m. the Police Control Room (PCR) received a call about the incident. After receiving information, the police officials reached the spot. The accused had been arrested in the case, however further investigation into the matter was in progress, said Station House Officer Baldev Kumar. The accused had been arrested under POSCO Act under Sections 376 and 511, he further stated. **DP**

Youth held for bid to rape 4-yr-old

A 19-year-old youth was arrested by the police for allegedly trying to rape a four-year-old girl staying in his neighbourhood at Mal-

The police received information that a minor girl was raped at Maloya village. They said the victim narrated the incident to her mother, who in turn informed the police. Later, the accused,

identified as Dharambir, was arrested by the police.

A case of rape, including Sections of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, has been registered against the accused at the Maloya police station.



31 arrested for drinking in public

Chandigarh: Police arrested 31 persons for consuming liquor at public place from different sectors on Saturday night and registered the suspects under the Punjab Police Act 2007. The offenders were later released from the police station. Among the total cases, Sector 26 police registered a maximum of five cases.

The accused was later identified as Santosh, a resident of Jagatpura in Mohali district, following which he was arrested. — TNS

Challans for wrong parking treble in UT

Traffic cops issue 12,360 slips against 4,407 last year

In a crackdown on wrong parking, the UT traffic police have issued as many as 12,360 challans till June 6 this year. The number of challans issued during the corresponding period last year was 4,407. Majority of the challans have been issued through wheel clamping.

Unauthorised parking of vehicles is one of the reasons for traffic snarls in the city. To deal with the problem, the traffic police started a campaign, which saw a three-time increase in the number of challans being issued for parking vehicles at unauthorised places.

A total of 6,276 challans were issued to the

motorists after clamping the wheels of wrongly parked vehicles across the city. Last year, only 550 challans were issued after using wheel clamps.

Challans issued after towing away wrongly parked vehicles also witnessed a steep rise with 2,916 offenders being penalised as compared to 726 during the corresponding period last year.

The police said in addition to wheel clamping

and towing away vehicles, as many as 3,168 challans were issued on the spot.

The police said wrong parking was rampant in Sectors 11, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 28, 30, 32, 34, 35 and 36.

"Traffic cops patrol the city along with towing vans and clamp wrongly parked vehicles. In addition, they tow away a wrongly parked vehicle, which is then dropped at the Traffic Lines, Sector 29," said a police official.



One held for burglary

CHANDIGARH: Luvkush, a resident of village Burail, Chandigarh reported that an unidentified person stolen away cash worth Rs 10,000 and jewellery from his house on June 9. A case under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code has been registered in Sector 34 Police Station, Chandigarh. Investigation into the case is in progress.
