सैक्टर-17 में गलत पार्क वाहन जब्त कर काटे चालान

■ सैक्टर-16 में गैर-कानूनी इशतिहार और होर्डिंग लगाने वालों पर पुलिस केस दर्ज करवाए

चंडीगढ़, 18 जून (सय): चंडीगढ़ नगर निगम के नवनियुक्त कमिश्नर के.के. यादव ने शहर में गैर-कानूनी स्थानों पर वाहन पार्क करने और होर्डिंग व इशतिहार लगाने वालों के विरुद्ध सख्त कार्रवाई करने के लिए निगम को आदेश दिए हैं। यादव ने वाहनों की गैर-कानूनी पार्किंग को गंभीरता से लेकर ऐसे स्थानों पर पार्क किए गए वाहनों को हटाने के लिए मुहिम चलाने के लिए कहा है। इसके साथ ही शहर की खूबसूरती को बिगाड़ रहे यहां की सड़कों और बाजारों में गैर-कानूनी तौर पर लगे होर्डिंग्स व इशतिहार लगाने वालों पर भी सख्ती के आदेश दिए गए हैं।

निगम कमिश्नर के आदेशों पर आज पहले दिन ही निगम की विशेष टीम ने कार्रवाई करते हुए सैक्टर-17 में गैर-कानूनी स्थानों पर पार्क किए गए वाहन जब्त किए और सैक्टर-16 में गैर-कानूनी इशतिहार व होर्डिंग लगाने वालों के खिलाफ पुलिस केस दर्ज करवाए गए। इसके बारे में नगर निगम के कमिश्नर के.के. यादव ने बताया कि नगर निगम द्वारा शहर में सड़कीय सुरक्षा को ध्यान में रखते हुए पूरे शहर में गैर-कानूनी पार्किंगों को हटाने के लिए निगम ने विशेष टीम बनाई है। उन्होंने शहरवासियों को अपील की कि वाहनों को निर्धारित स्थानों पर ही पार्क करें।

Police file chargesheet against three, including juvenile

CHANDIGARH POLICE on Monday filed a chargesheet against the three accused, including a juvenile, who were held for allegedly stabbing a man to death at Sector 25, Chandigarh, on March 29.

The chargesheet was submitted in the court of Judicial Magistrate First Class (JMFC) under sections 302 (murder), 307 (attempt to murder), 324 (voluntarily causing hurt by dangerous weapons or means) and 34 (acts done by several persons in furtherance of common intention) of the IPC, against Tarsem, Somi and the juvenile. Trial proceedings against the three will be held in the court of the Additional District and Sessions Judge.

According to police, the accused Tarsem and his accomplice Somi, along with a juvenile, had allegedly murdered a Sector

25 youth, namely Aman, on March 29. Tarsem, Somi and the juvenile were arrested for allegedly murdering 25-year-old Aman and injuring his brother-in-law Sunny (27) with a knife. Police said the accused had an altercation with Aman and Sunny at the Sector 37 petrol pump over refuelling vehicles first. On the night of March 29, while Sunny was on his way to drop Aman at Sector 25, around six youths, including Tarsem, Somi and the a juvenile, pounced on the duo and stabbed Aman, who succumbed to injuries in hospital, while Sunny, who suffered minor injuries, was discharged later.

Tarsem had earlier been arrested in three cases of theft in 2014 and he got acquitted in 2015. The juvenile, from whom the knife used in the murder of Aman was recovered, was not involved in any crime earlier. Somi, too, has no criminal background.



Woman slaps cop who stopped her 12-yr-old biker son, booked

CHANDIGARH: A Sector 46 resident has been booked for slapping a head constable who stopped and questioned her 12-year-old son for violating all sorts of rules by riding a motorcycle despite being underage and that too at breakneck speed without a helmet.

Head constable Tejbir Singh was on duty at a checkpoint in Sector 46 when he stopped the

juvenile. When the boy asked the policemen to call his parents his mother rushed to the spot and started arguing with them.

Officials said she lives in a government accommodation at Sector 46.

An official privy to the investigation said that, "Instead of asking her ward to follow traffic rules and not to drive without a license and helmet, the mother started arguing with the policeman on duty."

Later she turned violent and

assaulted Tejbir Singh when he asked the boy to stand at a distance, the police officer said.

Ajay Kumar, station house officer (SHO), Sector 34 police station, said the accused, identified as Baby, was booked under Section 323 (punishment for voluntarily causing hurt) and 353 (assault or criminal force to deter a public servant to discharge his or her duty) and 506 (punishment for criminal intimidation) of IPC.

She is yet to be arrested.

Woman booked for slapping cop on duty

A 41-YEAR-OLD woman was booked for slapping a Chandigarh Police head constable, who had stopped her underage son from driving a motorcycle, in Sector 46 on Sunday night. The woman, identified as Baby, is a resident of Sector 46.

Head Constable Tejbir Singh is posted at Sector 34 police station and he was on duty when he stopped the underage boy, Vivek, 13, who was returning along with his sister from a nearby gurdwara after taking sweetened water from a

chhabeel.

Baby alleged that Singh had stopped her son unnecessarily and she slapped the policeman after he started abusing her when she had gone to rescue Vivek. The incident happened around 10 pm.

Ashwani Kumar, husband of Baby, said, "Indeed, my son, who is an underage, was driving the motorcycle and his younger sister, Manik Kumari, 11, was riding pillion. But my wife, Baby, lost her temper when she saw that the policeman was slapping Vivek unnecessarily. As my wife intervened, the policeman used foul language for her and threatened her with dire conse-

quences. My wife lost her temper and slapped the policeman. My son Vivek suffered internal injuries and I rushed him to GMCH-32 last night. The policeman had also twisted the arm of my wife, who underwent a medical examination at GMCH-32. I rushed to the spot and made a call to police control room seeking police assistance. After around one hour, two policemen reached GMCH-32 and instead of recording our statements, they tried to hush up the matter. My son was admitted to the hospital for the whole night and he was discharged in the morning."

The head constable said, "I stopped the underage boy from

driving the motorcycle. The boy was without helmet. I did not slap him. The boy's mother came and started a heated argument with me and slapped me twice. There was no woman police constable with me on the spot. The allegations of woman and her husband are baseless. The woman had made a video clip on her cell phone."

Inspector Ajay Kumar, SHO of Sector 34 police station, said, "We lodged an FIR against the woman for assaulting a policeman and obstructing a government servant on duty. She has not been arrested till now. We are yet to receive any complaint from the woman's side."
