# 2 Delhi residents held in Ponzi scam

Were agents of mastermind Bhardwaj: Police

CHANDIGARH, MAY 25

The city police have arrested two Delhi residents claiming that they were agents of Bitcoin Ponzi king Amit Bhardwaj, who was recently arrested in Pune. Rajesh Jain and Sanchit were arrested on Thursday and were produced in a court on Friday, which sent the duo to three-day police remand. The police, however, had sought a 12-day remand.

The investigating officer (IO), Sub-Inspector Naveen, told the court that there were two transactions of the accused with Bhardwaj worth Rs 30 lakh and Rs 15 lakh. According to the police, the accused operated two Hong Kong-based companies wherein they asked people to invest in an 18-month scheme. They promised 10 per cent return each month, which they did for the initial two to three months. However, after that, the company disappeared and the people realised that they had been duped.

The IO told the court that they needed the remand to recover a laptop that could have important transaction details along with other items. The accused are to be taken to

## Get 3-day remand

Hanumangarh and Haridwar for the purpose. The police are already scrutinising over 40 bank accounts and suspect that there might be many more complainants in the case. The police have also applied for production warrants of Bhardwaj.

Bhardwaj, a bitcoin entrepreneur, was recently arrested by the Pune police for duping a large number of people to the tune of Rs 2,000 crore. Sources said three businessmen had approached the UT police alleging that they had invested 250 bitcoins on Bhardwaj's advice, who had assured them of huge returns. However, they neither got the returns nor the bitcoins.

The victims had purchased bitcoins from some website. Later, someone introduced them to Bhardwaj, who lured them to invest their bitcoins further into mining and transferred their bitcoins to himself.

## 2 men held by cyber crime cell

TWO MEN, involved in the multi-crore Bitcoin scam, were arrested and remanded in three days' police custody on Friday. Three persons had filed an FIR at the cyber crime cell against the two on May 7. The accused have been identified as Sanchit and Rajesh Kumar of Delhi. Both were arrested by the Chandigarh Police from Delhi.

Police said Sanchit and Rajesh were the agents of scam mastermind Amit Bhardwaj, CEO and founder of Gain Bitcoin, GB Minors and GB 21 firms, through which he lured investors, and two others, Pankaj Shri and Kishore Adalakha and Vikas Kadiyan, who are already facing a number of criminal cases for committing similar offences in various parts of the country, including Delhi, Pune and Bengaluru.

DSP (Cyber Cell) Rashmi Yadav Sharma said, "Around Rs 42 lakh of two of the three complainants was invested in three companies of Amit Bhardwaj through Sanchit and Rajesh. Amit Bhardwaj and his brother Vivek Bhardwaj did not accept any direct money from the investors. They appointed some of their agents through whom they transferred the money into their accounts and later invested that in Bitcoins. Amit Bhardwaj and Aditya Bhardwaj are currently in the judicial custody of Pune police and we will bring them here on production warrants." A case was registered at Sector 17 PS.

According to Chandigarh Police, Amit, along with brother Vivek, was arrested by Pune police from the IGI Airport when they returned from Bangkok on April 6. Chandigarh Police has now applied for Amit's production warrant to take him in their custody to interrogate him.



# TWO 'DRUG ADDICTS' HELD FOR ROBBING OLA DRIVER

**CHANDIGARH:** Police arrested two 'drug addicts' for robbing an OLA cab driver of ₹3,500 and ATM cards on Friday.

Investigating officer said cab driver Vikramjit Singh of Mohali alleged that Bhupinder Singh, 28, Aman, 19 and Gattu booked a cab asking them to pick up from Dhanas bridge late night.

On reaching the spot the three accused sat in the car and started beating Vikramjit.

Bhupinder and Aman have been arrested by the police.

Sarangpur station house officer (SHO) Ram Rattan said, "The accused had fled from the spot after taking all the cash and belongings

of Vikramjit. A case has been registered against them under Section 392 (punishment of robbery) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC)."

The SHO further said, "We are yet to arrest the third accused and will seek the remand of the two arrested. The trio committed the crime to earn easy money to buy drugs."

Both Bhupinder and Aman reside in Palsora.

# बेटियों से दुराचार करने वाले दोषी पिता को 20 साल की सजा दोषी पिता पर लगाया 2.05 लाख का जुर्माना

चंडीगढ़, 25 मई (संदीप): अपनी ही बेटियों से शारीरिक छेड़छाड़ और दुराचार मामले में दोषी पिता को अदालत ने 20 साल कैद की सजा सुनाते हुए 2.05 लाख का जुर्माना भी लगाया है।

जुर्माना राशि में से एक-एक लाख बतौर मुआवजा दोनों पीड़ित बेटियों को देने के आदेश दिए गए हैं। बता दें कि पिछले साल आई.टी. पार्क थाना पुलिस ने दोनों बच्चियों द्वारा चाइल्ड हैल्पलाइन में शिकायत के बाद उनके पिता के खिलाफ केस दर्ज किया था। 25 सितंबर 2017 को थाना पुलिस को दी शिकायत में 16 वर्षीय पीड़िता ने कहा था कि, उसकी मां का देहांत हो चुका था। पिता उससे शारीरिक छेड़छाड़ और अश्लील हरकतें करते थे। जिस कारण वह तारा

के साथ रह रही थीं। वहीं उसकी 7 साल की छोटी बहन और 4 वर्षीय भाई पिता के साथ मकान के ही ग्राउंड फ्लोर पर रहते थे। 24 सितंबर को बड़ी बहन को छोटी बहन ने उसे बताया कि पिता उससे गलत हरकतें करते हैं। उसके प्राइवेट पार्ट से छेड़खानी करते हैं। बड़ी बहन ने पास स्थित डिस्पेंसरी में महिला डॉक्टर को जानकारी दी। डॉक्टर ने चाइल्ड हैल्पलाइन को सूचित किया। हैल्पलाइन टीम ने दोनों बच्चियों की कार्कसलिंग में पाया कि दोषी पहले बड़ी और फिर छोटी बेटों से शारीरिक छेड़छाड़ कर चुका है।
