

Vigilant cops apprehend robbery accused lurking in district courts

CHANDIGARH: High drama was witnessed at Chandigarh District Courts after cops identified a man as a robbery accused and a chase ensued.

The cops, posted as naib courts, managed to nab the accused, who was identified as Gaurav alias Gora.

Gaurav was booked under Sections 394 (voluntarily caus-

ing hurt in committing robbery), 341 (wrongful restraint) and 506 (criminal intimidation) of the Indian Penal Code at the Sector 32 police station in 2017.

A court had issued warrants against him as part of proceedings to declare him a proclaimed offender.

He was reportedly at the district courts on Saturday to sur-

render, when naib court Ashok Kumar identified him, and he along with another naib court, Sonu, tried to apprehend him. Spotting the cops, Gaurav tried to run away, but was nabbed. He was produced in the court from where he was sent to judicial custody. Another case was registered against him for assaulting the policemen. **HTC**

Drug addicts: 2 held for snatching

CHANDIGARH: Two persons who were allegedly involved in snatching and theft cases held on Saturday. The Police officer said that two persons held in Snatching cases. A team led by Inspector Punam Dilawari, SHO Police Station Sector-26 nabbed two snatchers who snatched a purse from Sector 21 on November 16. Both were also involved in many other cases of snatching and vehicles theft also. Recently they had stolen a motorcycle from Sector-15 and the same motorcycle has been used by them in present snatching case



and other cases also. The stolen motorcycle and other articles of snatched purse have been recovered from the accused persons.

The accused have been identified as Shubham and Pradeep. Shubham is attending training as lab technician at Sector 34 and

diploma holder of Lab Technician from College situated at Sector-26, Chandigarh and currently living at New Indira Colony Manimajra. Another accused Pardeep, resident of Rohtak, is a well-educated and working in Call Centre. In course of interrogation it has been revealed that both are addicted to smoking and drinking and in habit to play gambling etc. To fulfillment of their requirement they started stealing vehicles and further started snatching on stolen vehicle to avoid the identification and arrest from police.
