

ORDER

It has come to notice that some of the police employees, who have been allotted police pool accommodation by the department, have sub let their allotted houses to other employees/private persons, which is contrary to the allotment rules besides misuse of government facility amounting to grave misconduct. A large number of police employees genuinely require government accommodation and are awaiting their turns to mature on availability of government houses. As such, subletting of house by the police employees cannot be tolerated. Under the Police Pool House Allotment Rules, "Subletting" has been defined as **"letting out and includes sharing of the whole or any part of the residence by an allottee with another person, with or without payment of rent by such person"**. The rules further clearly prohibit police employees to share the residences allotted to them out of police pool except with the members of their family.

2. As such, it has been decided to conduct a surprise physical verification of all the police pool houses shortly. All those police employees, who are allottee of police pool houses and have sub let their police houses or are sharing with the persons other than their family members are, hereby, advised to immediately surrender their houses within seven days so that the same could be allotted to the police employees who are waiting for the allotment of houses. In case, thereafter, during physical verifications, any police house is found sub let, the same will be cancelled from the name of the allottee police employee besides facing disciplinary action. On cancellation they will also be liable to pay market rent at penal rate i.e. 50 times of the normal rent.

3. All In charge Units will display this order on the notice boards of their units besides briefing the staff during morning and evening roll calls for next one week continuously. A copy of the order will also be displayed on the Chandigarh Police website for the information of police employees.
