

Instructions for the written exam of B-1 Test to be held on 6.10.2024

1. Candidates shall attend the exam in proper uniform.
2. Roll number for the examination will be the same as the Belt number of the official. Roll Number will be of 4 digits. If the belt number is of less than 4 digits, 0s will be prefixed to the belt number to make it 4 digits. For instance, if belt number of the official is 7, then Roll Number will be 0007.
3. Examination will consist of 90 Multiple choice questions, each carrying one mark. There shall be no negative marking. Candidates will be provided OMR sheet for marking the correct answers.
4. Candidates can carry only the following items with them to the examination venue:
 - I. Valid Chandigarh Police ID card (in original)
 - II. Two ball pens (Blue/black)
 - III. One transparent/plain card board
5. Candidates are advised not to bring any valuable items to the examination venue as the safe keeping of the same cannot be ensured.
6. Inside the test venue, candidate must ensure that He/ She has signed, along with applying thumb impression, on the attendance sheet.
7. Once candidate enters the examination venue, he/ she will not be permitted to leave the venue before the test is over.
8. On completion of the test, candidates will be permitted to leave the venue in an orderly manner. They must wait for the instructions and should not leave the venue until advised. Before leaving, candidates must also ensure that they have handed over their question booklets and OMR sheets to their respective invigilators.
9. Entry will start from 8AM onwards from Gate No 2 of Police Lines, Sector 26, Chandigarh.
10. Candidates won't be allowed entry to exam venue after gate closing time i.e. 9:30 AM.
11. Entry to examination venue will be permitted only against valid Chandigarh Police identity card in original.
12. It is advised to bring along two ball pens(blue/black) and one transparent/plain card board for the written test.
13. Candidates are advised to properly read all the instructions given on the Question Booklet and OMR answer sheet.
14. Candidates who fail to appear on the designated date shall not be provided a second opportunity.
15. Impersonation or fraud/ use of any kind of unfair means in any case would result not only debarring the candidate but criminal and departmental proceedings would also be initiated against the candidate.
16. Candidates are not permitted to carry any electronic devices (mobile phones, calculators, smartwatches), bags, or study materials to the examination venue.
