NOTIFICATION

No.1/1/190-HIII(1)-2021/8326 - In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification bearing S.O 3267 dated the 1<sup>st</sup> November 1966, the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh, is pleased to make the following rules to the Union Territory, Chandigarh namely :-

1. These rules may be called promotion rules of Constables in Chandigarh Police-2024.
2. These shall come into force with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2024.
3. In the first instance, eligible Constables will be granted List-"B" to eligible Constables meant for deputing them for promotion course (Lower School Course).
4. Further Lower School Qualified Constables will be granted List-"C" according to which they will be promoted to the rank of Head Constable.

List "B":- Selection for admission to promotion course for constables at the Police Training College:-

(1) List 'B' shall be maintained by Superintendent of Police. It will include the names of all constables selected for admission to the promotion course for Constables at the Police Training College. Selection shall be made on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of month in which DPC is held and will be limited to the number of vacancies available in the year with a 20 percent reserve. Efficiency and honesty shall be the main factors governing selection. Names will be entered in the list by following ways by the Departmental Promotion Committee constitute by the Inspector General of Police/Inspector General of Police:-

1. 70% by way of seniority-cum-merit.
2. 25% by way of B-1 Test, in order of merit determined by the Departmental Promotion Committee constituted by the Inspector-General of Police on the basis of test in parade, general law (Indian Penal Code, Criminal Procedure Code and Police Rules), and examination of records.
3. 5% from the sports quota (All India Level or International Level).

Provided that in inter-se-seniority in the above three categories 70% will be senior, 25% will be junior to 70% & will be in their order of merit achieved by them in the B-1 Test and 5% will be junior to 70% and 25% and their inter-se-seniority will be according to their date of appointment as Constable.

(2) All Constables who are directly recruited in the U.T. Police; and

1. who have put in more than three years of service; or
2. who obtain first Class with credit in the Recruits Course will be eligible to have their names entered on the aforesaid list, if they are not above thirty years of age on the first day of month in which the selection is made:

Provided that no Constable who has been awarded a major punishment within a period of three years preceding the first day of the month in which selection is made will be eligible for admission to his list besides this last three years ACRs shall be considered and if any Constable whose name has been brought on this list is not sent to the Police Training College in the year he will be required to complete again with the new candidates, if he is still eligible for admission to the said list under the rules.

(3) Temporary Constables brought on list 'B' shall be absorbed in the regular establishment in preference to other.

(4) No Constable who has failed to qualify in the promotion course for Constable shall be re-admitted to list 'B' unless the Principal Police Training College for the reasons to be recorded in writing considers him deserving of another chance and he is still eligible. The reasons are to be communicated to the Senior Superintendent of Police.

(5) (1) List "C". Promotion to Head Constables:- (1) a list shall be maintained by Establishment Branch of PHQ of all constables who have passed the Lower School Course at any recognized Training Centre and considered eligible for promotion to Head Constable. The list shall be kept confidentially by the Superintendent and shall be scrutinized and approved by the Director General of Police or Deputy Inspector General of Police.

(2) Promotions to rank of Head Constable shall be made as per the merit in the Lower School Course tempered by seniority. Efficiency and honesty shall be the main factors governing selection. The date of admission to List "C" shall not be material, but the order of merit in which examinations have been passed shall be taken into consideration in comparing qualifications. In cases where other qualifications are equal, seniority in the police force shall be deciding factor. Selection grade Constables who have not passed the Lower School Course at the Police Training School but are otherwise considered suitable may, with the approval of the Director General of Police or Inspector General of Police, be promoted to Head Constable up to a maximum of ten percent of vacancies.

(6) **Power to Relax:** Where the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons, to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules in respect of any class or category of persons.

**Note :** However, Chandigarh Police Department reserve the right to merge, restructure or drop any existing Rule/Sub-Rule with the approval of Competent Authority in consultation with the Home Department, Chandigarh Administration.
