**No.1/1/156-HIII(1)/** In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of Constitution of India, read with Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification SO. No. 3267, dated 1<sup>st</sup> November, 1966 in Supersession of all the recruitment Rules for the posts of Tailor and Carpenter notified by the various department of the Chandigarh Administration, the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh, hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the post of **Tailor & Carpenter** (Group-C) in the Chandigarh Police, U.T., Chandigarh, namely:-

**1. Short title and Commencement-** These rules may be called the Chandigarh Police Tailor & Carpenter Recruitment Rules, 2024.

(i) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Number of posts, Classification, level in pay matrix or scale of pay:-**  
The number of said post, its classification and pay level in the pay matrix or pay scale attached thereto, shall be specified in column (2) to (4) of the schedule annexed to these rules.

**3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualification, etc.:-** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters related to the said posts shall be specified in columns No. (6) to (12) of the said Schedule.

**4. Disqualification :-**

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living,

OR

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage, with any person, shall be eligible for the appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt, any person from the operation of this rule.

**5. Powers to relax:-** Where the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of person.

**6. Savings.-**Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen or any other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by Central Government from time to time in this regard.
