



PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING REVISED MERIT LIST OF CBT FOR RECRUITMENT OF 520 CONSTABLES IN CHANDIGARH POLICE

- 1.** Computer Based Test (CBT) of shortlisted candidates who had qualified the Physical Measurement and Endurance Test was conducted in 2018 for recruitment of 520 constables in Chandigarh Police.
- 2.** The result and answer key of CBT was declared on 31.12.2018. After the declaration of result, some representations were received by Chandigarh Police on the issue of incorrect questions/answer key. Due to this, the result had to be withdrawn and cancelled.
- 3.** On the basis of these representations, Chandigarh Police had directed the Service Provider engaged for the conduct of CBT to get all questions and answer key of CBT and representations received from candidates independently scrutinized by a panel of reputed subject matter experts.
- 4.** Thereafter, all the candidates were duly informed to login to the "Answer Key Grievance Redressal System" on the website of Chandigarh Police to view their individual attempted question paper and revised answer key as per their batch during the period starting from 0900 hours on 31.01.2019 to 0900 hours on 02.02.2019. Further, candidates were also provided another opportunity to raise grievances regarding the revised answer key.

- 5.** A total of 2185 grievances regarding 361 questions were received from 791 candidates. All the grievances received from candidates have been examined by two independent panels of subject matter experts.
- 6.** As per the scrutiny report of the two independent panels of subject matter experts, out of a total of 700 questions of CBT, the answer key of 11 questions has been revised and 10 questions have been declared invalid. While these 10 incorrect questions have not been considered for evaluation but in order to achieve parity across all batches, the total marks obtained by candidates have been extrapolated against 100 questions.
- 7.** In view of the above, the revised merit list of provisionally selected candidates and waitlisted candidates of all categories has been uploaded on the website of Chandigarh Police.
- 8.** The provisionally selected candidates are instructed to report at Recruitment Cell, Recruit Training Centre (RTC), Police Lines, Sector-26, Chandigarh at 10 AM on 05.03.2019 (Tuesday) positively. They should bring two passport size photographs, original Aadhaar card, original Driving License and other original documents relating to age, educational qualifications, category and Discharge Book in case of Ex-servicemen. - 9.** All candidates who appeared in CBT shall be informed about marks obtained by them through their registered email address.
