

The objectives, coverage and sample are only indicative of the minimum requirements. The study may encompass any other aspect which is relevant to the research topic.

1.	<p>Study of Repeat Offenders of Major Crimes</p> <p>a) The objectives of the study should encompass:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. To analyse the profile of repeat offenders i.e. age/sex/education /income/employment/domicile/family history & relationships/socio-economic status and their psychological traits, etc.2. To identify the causes that compel offenders to become repeat offenders.3. To understand the modus operandi of repeat offenders.4. To evolve strategies for reformation, rehabilitation and assimilation in the society of repeat offenders to prevent recidivism. <p>b) Study should cover 2 States from each of the regions i.e. North, South, East, West, Central and North East with interviews of at least 50 such offenders, 20 police personnel and 20 prison officers in each region.</p>
2.	<p>Study of Narcotic Criminals held for possession of Commercial Quantity</p> <p>a) The objectives of the study should encompass:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. To analyse the profile of narcotic criminals i.e. age/sex/education /income/ employment/ domicile/family history & relationships/socio-economic status and their psychological traits, etc.2. To identify the reasons for committing narcotic crimes.3. To understand the modus operandi of narcotic criminals.4. To evolve strategies for the reformation, rehabilitation and assimilation in the society of such criminals to prevent recidivism. <p>b) Study should cover 2 States from each of the regions i.e. North, South, East, West, Central and North East with interviews of 25 such offenders, 10 police personnel and 10 prison officers in each region.</p>

3.	<p>Modus Operandi and Profiling of Offenders Convicted for Snatching</p> <p>a) The objectives of the study should encompass:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To analyse the profile of offenders convicted for snatching i.e. age/sex/education /income/employment/ domicile/family history & relationships/ socio-economic status and their psychological traits, etc. 2. To understand the modus operandi adopted by the snatchers. 3. To find out the nature and extent of snatching that is reported to the Police. 4. To examine the methods and procedures followed by the police while handling these cases 5. To find out the challenges faced by the police while handling these cases. 6. To suggest preventive measures for reducing the incidents of snatching. <p>b) Study should cover 2 States from each of the regions i.e. North, South, East, West, Central and North East with interviews of 50 such offenders, 25 police personnel and 10 prison officers in each region.</p>
4.	<p>Modus Operandi and Profiling of Offenders Convicted for Sexual Offences against Women and Children</p> <p>a) The objectives of the study should encompass:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To analyse the profile of offenders convicted for sexual offences against women and children i.e. age/sex/education /income/employment/ domicile/ family history & relationships/socio-economic status and their psychological traits, etc. 2. To understand the modus operandi of offenders convicted for sexual offences. 3. To identify the reasons for committing sexual offences. 4. To identify the perception of sexual offenders towards their crime and victims. 5. To evolve reformation, rehabilitation and assimilation in society strategies for sexual offenders to prevent recidivism. <p>b) Study should cover 2 States from each of the regions i.e. North, South, East, West, Central and North East with interviews of 50 such offenders, 25 police personnel and 10 prison officers in each region.</p>
