To aware the women, especially girl students about the recently launched women app smart 24x7, a team of police officials headed by Mrs. Kamla Meena DSP/W&CSU along with Inspector Punam Dilawari, SHO PS-26, Inspector Kuldip Kaur, I/C CRU and Mr. Bhupinder Saini of "Smart 24x7 Group" visited at MCM College Sector-36 and briefed the students "How to down load the app on mobile phones" and it's features and benefits. Students were also informed that the app is fully operational and police can provide help to the women/person using the panic button on app feature by tracing the location through alert received in Police Control Room, Chandigarh. They were also informed that the app is more beneficial in the situation where a person is unable to dial-100 number, in such a situation she has to press the on/off switch 5/6 times continuously or long press of panic button. Students assured the team to share the knowledge of app features with their friends and family members.

DSP/W&CSU briefed them for using the women helpline number 1091 frequently or may contact her personally for any child abuse/sexual harassment. Inspector Punam Dilawari briefed the students not to influence by unknown friends of social network sites like facebook. If such element force them to do something wrong or extorting money, pass the information to the police timely so that they can be trapped. She assured the girl students to take prompt action if any sexual harassment information is received even on her personal contact number. Principal MCM College Sec-36 appreciated the efforts made by Chandigarh Police for the safety of women in Chandigarh and assure to motivate the students for down-loading the app smart 24x7 so that it can be used in emergency situation.
