Lawyer comes to GMCH to settle family dispute, fires gunshots, held

PANIC GRIPPED the Government Medical College and Hospital (GMCH), Sector 32, on Sunday afternoon when a lawyer who came to settle a family dispute fired four gunshots in the air outside the hospital's mortuary. People caught the lawyer and handed him over to the police, following which the police registered a case against the accused and arrested him.

According to the Sector 34 Station House Officer (SHO), Inspector Ajay Kumar, they booked Banur resident Gagandeep Singh and recovered a .32 bore revolver from him. The SHO added that the firing incident occurred around 12 noon when Gagandeep Singh came to the hospital with one Jagwinder Singh.

The SHO told Chandigarh Newslines that Jagwinder Singh's wife Gurjinder Kaur, 31, had been admitted to the hospital since May 30 after she suffered an injury. Gurjinder Kaur's family alleged that she attempted to commit suicide due to some issues with her in-laws.

"On Sunday, members of Gurjinder's in-laws came to meet her for settling the issue. Gurjinder's husband Jagwinder Singh, who is a lineman with power department, Gagandeep Singh and some others met the family members of Gurjinder Kaur outside the hospital's mortuary, but their discussions led to heated arguments, following which Gagandeep took out his revolver and fired four gunshots in the air," the SHO said.

The SHO said that Gagandeep Singh told them that he fired the gunshots as he got scared that Gurjinder's family members

could manhandle him.

The SHO said that they booked Gagandeep Singh under section 336 (act endangering life or personal safety of others) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and sections 25, 27, 59 of the Arms Act at the Sector 34 police station on the complaint of Gurjinder Kaur's brother Amandeep Singh.

Amandeep Singh told Chandigarh Newslines that his sister had married Jagwinder Singh eight years ago and the couple had two daughters. He alleged that

Gurjinder's in-laws family did not like her as she did not have any son.

"On May 30, she attempted to commit suicide by hanging herself from a ceiling fan, but her husband saw her and stopped her from doing so. Her in-laws took her to GMCH-32 and also informed us that she was injured when she was going to the market with her husband. When we came to the hospital, they (in-law family members) all left the hospital. My sister told me the reality," Amandeep Singh said.



Two booked for stalking 30-yr-old woman scooterist

CHANDIGARH: Police have booked two unidentified motorcycle-borne men for allegedly stalking a woman scooterist.

In her complaint to the police, the 30-year-old woman said she went to the Sector 43 bus stand to drop her friend around 2am on Friday. On her way back from Kajheri to Sector 34, two men on a motorcycle started following her and tried to stop her.

Sector 36 station house officer (SHO) Ranjodh Singh said, "The complainant didn't have clear details of the suspects or their

vehicle's number, except that it had a Punjab registration number. We have started scrutinising CCTV cameras' footage to identify the culprits."

A case under Section 354-D (stalking) of the Indian Penal Code has been registered against the accused.
