# महिला का फोन छीनकर भागा स्नैचर पुलिस ने पकड़ा

सेक्टर-20 की रहने वाली एक महिला को फोन स्नैच कर लिया गया। पुलिस ने स्नैचर को पकड़कर मोबाइल बरामद कर लिया है। पकड़े गए आरोपी की पहचान हाउसिंग बोर्ड लाइट प्वाइंट के रहने वाले राम लाल के रूप में हुई है। बताया गया कि घटना मौलीजागरां की है। महिला पैदल जा रही थी। अचानक एक लड़का आया और मोबाइल छीनकर भाग गया। महिला चिल्लाई भी, लेकिन जब तक कोई स्नैचर को पकड़ता वह भागने में कामयाब हो गया। इसके बाद घटना की बारे में पुलिस को सूचना दी गई। महिला ने पुलिस को शिकायत दी है कि किसी ने उनका मोबाइल फोन स्नैच कर लिया है। मामले में मौलीजागरां थाना पुलिस ने केस दर्ज करने के बाद इन्वेस्टीगेशन शुरू की और पाया कि मोबाइल फोन स्विच ऑफ नहीं हुआ है। दरअसल आरोपी मोबाइल की बैटरी नहीं निकाल पाया। पुलिस ने तुरंत लोकेशन लेकर सर्च की तो आरोपी को गिरफ्तार कर लिया गया।



## Action taken against gambling

**CHANDIGARH:** Chandigarh Police have arrested Naushad, a resident of Sector 38/W, Chandigarh while gambling near his house and recovered cash worth Rs 650 from his possession. A case under Sections 13A-3-67 of the Gambling Act has been registered at Maloya Police Station, Chandigarh. However, later he was released on bail. Investigation into the case is underway. Meanwhile, in an another case Chandigarh Police have arrested three more gamblers near Tikona Park, DMC, Chandigarh and recovered cash worth Rs 750 from their possession. Further investigation into the case is in on.

# Amid tight security, cops recover mobile along with sim cards

The Burail Jail authorities on Friday recovered three mobile phones and SIM cards from Burail Jail. Mobile phone and sim cards were recovered from the barrack of a notorious criminal, Rajan Bhatti. Sector 49 Police Station had also registered a case under Sections 420, 419 of the Indian Penal Code against accused Rajan Bhatti.

The authorities on the basis of the report of intelligence have conducted a raid in the jail and recovered mobile phones from the jail, amid many jammers installed within the jail. Police are investigating that how mobile phones got entered in the jail. Also, a check is done by the police officials twice in a day.

As per the sources, police are investigating that whether there is any involvement of any insider into the matter. Police are scrutinising the details of the calls made by Rajan Bhatti .

“We keep on checking the jails as such raids are a part of our routine. Everything is under control. Further investigation into the case is on, we will take stern action if anyone found of guilty, said Inspector General (prisons) Dr OP Mishra.
